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Coaching Application Overview

Lac St Louis Ringette is beginning to structure and implement the 2020/2021 Regional team coaching staffs.

The application contained herein is calling for coaching applications for the Regional Program (U16AA and U19AA). The coaching position starts in May 2020, ending in April 2021.

As a regional team program, Lac St Louis Ringette's program is intended to identify, develop and prepare the team to compete at a national level.

Please note:

- 1- Coaching applications are to be made to Lac St Louis Ringette. The selection committee will consider the successful candidates for these two teams in such a manner as to allow both the program and the coaching staff to complement one another, allowing each to grow in a positive manner.
- 2- The head coach position is a volunteer position.

The Application Process

All applicants for the 2020/2021 season can be emailed, but must be received by Lac St Louis Ringette on/or **before April 1st, 2020**. Deadline for head coach shortlist submission to Lac St Louis board for approval is **April 7th, 2020**

Short-listing of coaching applicants and notification to successful and non-successful applicants will be completed **by April 7th**. All/Any necessary interviews will take place the week of **April 13th 2020**. Announcement of the **2020-2021** U16AA –U19AA head coaches will be made no later than **April 17th 2020**.

Timelines and Commitments for Successful Candidates

April 24th- May 17th - 2020 – Selection Camp (rough estimate)

May 17th 2020 – Teams finalized

Oct 1st 2020 – Deadline for coaching staff to be submitted for Lac St Louis board approval

September 2020– May 2021 – Ringuette Season

May 1st 2021 – Return completed player evaluations for 2020/2021 teams



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Selection Criteria

The following five categories detail the criteria employed during the selection process for the coaching staff of Lac St Louis Ringette U16AA and U19AA regional teams. The selection criteria shall include but not be limited to the following:

1- Coaching Experience

- Previous ringette experience and results.
- Success as a ringette coach/player.
- Years of experience as a ringette coach.
- Scope of experience (league play, tournaments, provincials, nationals).
- Category or categories of experience as a coach/player.
- Personal coaching philosophy.
- Active full time coaching.

2- Knowledge of Ringette

- Knowledge of styles employed by various regions/provinces.
- Ability to recognize and select quality ringette players that will be successful in the regional program.
- Knowledge and understanding of potential game adjustments and facilitating them during the course of a competition – having a good “feel” of the game.

3- Professional Development

- CI – CI2 certification attained in Ringette Canada’s Coaching Certification Program.
- Attendance and participation of all coaching staff in Regional coaching meetings held by AA Coordinator.

4- Human Resources

- Proven ability to work in a team-coaching situation.
- Proven ability to successfully relate to and work with players at this age level.
- Proven ability to provide positive reinforcement to players in both practice and game situations
- Proven ability to successfully cope with deterrents and hardships in a season or competition.
- Proven ability to handle demands of a regional program.

5- Knowledge of the program

- Proven ability to work towards objectives of a program.
- Proven ability to successfully serve as a spokesperson for the team.
- Proven interest in selecting the best possible ringette players to form a team, regardless of their point of origin.
- Proven appreciation for and awareness of the unique problems that can occur in the selection and operation of a regional team.
- Proven history of adherence and support of AA policies and procedures and willingness to work within the system



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Professional Development

All coaches that are successfully selected for Lac St Louis staff will be required to attend a coach's meeting. A meeting that will be structured for the coaching staff to begin to prepare plans for the operation of their respective teams. This meeting provides the opportunity for the coaching staff to begin their working relationship with one another and understand the goals of the program set forth by Lac St Louis Ringette. The entire program will be outlined to the successful candidates upon acceptance.

Conclusion

It is the policy of Lac St Louis Ringette that anyone applying for a regional team coaching or support staff position is subject to a screening process. Applicants, must submit a current Criminal Record search, and provide a list of references.
